

SparkSafe Licence Types & Criteria

The SparkSafe Electrical Licence to Practise system has been designed to inform Clients of the identity and occupational competency of electrical workers who are trained, assessed and qualified specifically in electrical installation practice.

Four licence types have been determined for the benefit and understanding of the Client. The licence types available for electrical workers include – Licence to Practise for Assessed Qualified Electrician, Qualified Electrician, Restricted Electrical Worker and Apprentice Electrician.

Apprentice Electrician

This licence type demonstrates that the person is working towards becoming fully qualified by means of an industry approved framework/standard. Apprentices will be issued with a standard licence for all year groups.

Supporting Evidence	
1.	Personal Training Plan [PTP] confirming the person is working towards achieving a Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Installing Electrotechnical Systems. The PTP must state framework/standard number, framework/standard title, course start and end date and employer. A letter from college on headed paper can be accepted or an email directly from the college containing the required information will be accepted.
2.	Photographic ID - Passport, driving licence or electoral card only.
3.	Digital Photograph - Head shot against a plain white background, must be emailed.
4.	Employment Verification Table is only required if the Personal Training Plan does not have your current employer information.
